**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
B4156 HOBNOCK ROAD, ESSINGTON**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 2 August 2022 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of B4156 Hobnock Road in Essington from its junction with B4156 Brownshore Lane and Bognop Road to outside St Johns Primary School unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works. Access for pedestrians will be available.

An alternative route for traffic is available via A462 Bursnips Road, Upper Sneyd Road, Brownshore Lane, B4156 Brownshore Lane and vice versa. For more information, visit: <https://one.network/?tm=124079593>.

The order will come into operation on 8 August 2022 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26 August 2022.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the Cadent Gas works for a gas mains replacement, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
